

101 is the number to call when you want to contact your local police in a non-emergency.



My vehicle has been damaged or stolen

There's suspicious people/vehicles and activity in my local area

My property has been vandalised

I suspect someone is drug dealing in my neighbourhood

My phone has been stolen and I need a crime number

I'd like to report some anti-social behaviour

Just a few examples of when 101 should be used. In an emergency or if a crime is in progress call 999.

Calls from landlines and mobile networks cost 15 pence per call, no matter what time of day or how long your call.

If you are deaf, hard of hearing or speech impaired you can textphone 18001 101
